Executive Summary


Tucked in the scenic Wyoming Black Hills, just 17 miles northwest of Spearfish and four miles northeast of Beulah, the Mullenger Ranch presents a rare opportunity to own a Black Hills property with significant recreational appeal. Encompassing approximately 960± deeded acres and surrounded by expansive neighboring holdings, the ranch offers remarkable privacy and seclusion. Its diverse landscape showcases rolling meadows, wooded draws, striking rimrock outcrops, and elevated plateaus-each contributing to sweeping views and exceptional wildlife habitat. The varied topography provides numerous ideal sites for a custom home or secluded mountain retreat. Deep, timber-lined canyons shaded by Ponderosa pines and oak trees conceal natural springs and ponds, while an artesianfed pipeline delivers water to improved tanks for livestock and game alike. The ranch supports a rich wildlife population, including elk, mule deer, whitetail deer, turkey, bald and golden eagles, falcons, hawks, owls, bobcats, and mountain lions.

Carefully managed and thoughtfully preserved, Mullenger Ranch is a standout recreational retreat with excellent wildlife resources and solid grazing for livestock.
