

FIELD NOTES
15.26 ACRE

BEING 15.26 acres out of the northwest 1/4 of the south 1/2 of the James R. Munson Survey No. 424, Taylor County, Texas, said 15.26 acres being part of a 184.6 acre tract described as First Tract in Volume 2306, Page 103, Official Public Records, Taylor County, Texas and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2" spike found at the northwest corner of the south 1/2 of said Survey No. 424, the northwest corner of said 184.6 acre tract and the southwest corner of a 22.75 acre tract recorded in Instrument No. 2022-05889, Official Public Records, Taylor County, Texas for the northwest corner of this tract;

THENCE S88°49'18"E 829.74 feet to a railroad spike found on the WBL of the Abilene & Southern Railroad right-of-way (abandoned) at the southeast corner of said 22.75 acre tract for the northeast corner of this tract;


THENCE S12°23'36"W 917.32 feet along the WBL of said abandoned railroad right-of-way to a 3/8" rebar set for the southeast corner of this tract, whence a 1/2" rebar found at the northeast corner of a 2.91 acre tract recorded in Instrument No. 2016-14932, Official Public Records, Taylor County, Texas bears S12°23'36"W 1843.70';

THENCE N88°49'18"W 647.75 feet to a 3/8" rebar set on the WBL of said Survey No. 424 for the southwest corner of this tract;

THENCE N0°57'02"E 899.81 feet along the WBL of said Survey No. 424 to the place of beginning and containing 15.26 acres of land.
