

NOTICE

of the regulatory authority of the

COW CREEK GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

You are hereby notified that real property in Kendall County falls under the jurisdiction of the Cow Creek Groundwater Conservation District (CCGCD). The CCGCD is a political subdivision of the State of Texas with responsibility to preserve, conserve and protect the groundwater resources of Kendall County. Its statutory authority is defined in Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code. The CCGCD is governed by a locally elected Board of Directors and funded by ad valorem taxes at a rate of one-half of one cent per one hundred dollars of property valuation (\$ 0.005 / \$ 100.00).

All existing water wells are subject to registration with CCGCD. Additionally, any new well must be applied for and registered with CCGCD prior to drilling. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in civil penalties and, in extreme cases, may involve mandatory well closure as prescribed by CCGCD Rules.
