\$\$\$ REFUNDS

You may qualify for one or both refunds from the State of Minnesota based on your 2023 Property Taxes.

If you owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2023, you **may** qualify for one or both of the following homestead credit refunds:

- Property Tax Refund** - If your taxes exceed certain income-based thresholds, and your total household income is less than \$128,280.
- Special Property Tax Refund** - If you also owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2022 and **both** of the following are true:
 - The net property tax on your homestead increased by more than 12% from 2022 to 2023.
 - The increase was at least \$100, not due to improvements on the property.

Penalty For Late Payment Of Property Tax

If you pay your first half or second half property tax after the due dates, a penalty will be added to your tax. The later you pay, the greater the penalty you must pay. The table below shows the penalty amounts added to your tax if your property taxes are not paid before the date shown.

Personal Property Located on Leased Government-owned Land: Taxes

may be paid in two installments due at the same time as real property taxes. These taxes are subject to the same penalty schedule and penalty rates as real property taxes. All other personal property taxes are due in full on or before May 15, 2023.

Note to manufactured homeowners:

The title to your manufactured home cannot be transferred unless all current year and delinquent personal property taxes are paid at the time of transfer.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- TAXPAYERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT OF TAX AND THIS IS NOT AFFECTED BY FAILURE TO PROVIDE A STATEMENT FOR A PARCEL.
- WE DO NOT MAIL SECOND HALF STATEMENTS.
- PAYMENT - WE ARE PROHIBITED FROM ACCEPTING POST-DATED CHECKS. PAYMENT MUST BE IN U.S. DOLLARS BY MONEY ORDER, OR DRAFT FROM A U.S. BANK OR BRANCH. DRAFT MUST HAVE BANK'S CODED TRANSIT NUMBER ALONG BOTTOM EDGE.
- M.S. 276.017 SUBD. 3. **PROOF OF TIMELY PAYMENT.** THE POSTMARK OR REGISTRATION MARK OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE QUALIFIES AS PROOF OF TIMELY MAILING. MAILING, OR THE TIME OF MAILING, MAY ALSO BE ESTABLISHED BY A DELIVERY SERVICE'S RECORDS OR OTHER AVAILABLE EVIDENCE. SENIOR CITIZEN PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL

The Senior Citizen Deferral Program provides a low-interest loan to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

- Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and
- Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as you participate in this program.

To be eligible, you must file an application by **November 1, 2023**, as well as:

- Be at least 65 years old,
- Have a household income of \$60,000 or less, and
- Have lived in your home for at least 15 years.
